The mission of Lloyd's Register Foundation — to engineer a safer world — is fundamentally underpinned by research and evidence, and the World Risk Poll is a powerful tool to understand the nature and scale of safety challenges across the globe.

The Poll gives a voice to people around the world, including in places where there is little existing data on risk.

Running biannually with a core of repeating questions supplemented by bespoke modules; the Poll captures the views and concerns of over 125,000 people from over 120 countries in each wave . These repeating questions and modules are shown below for easy reference for 2019, 2021, 2023 and 2025.

We invite stakeholders to contact us to discuss the inclusion of topics and questions in future iterations of the World Risk Poll. Decisions around suitability will be based on the following criteria: demonstrable potential to have meaningful impact, alignment with the Foundation's mission, and feasibility.
